Eric Bescoby - The "Big U" – Cruising Maine to Alaska and Vice-Versa

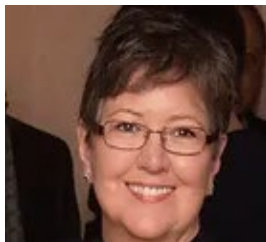
Licensed Yacht Salesperson in California

Mario Vittone – Four in Ten – Handling the Most Dangerous Mistakes in Cruising



Global Project Manager, Lifesaving Systems

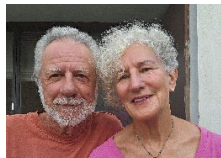
By far the most dangerous thing offshore is the water that surrounds you. To be safe everyone aboard must understand the risks of going overboard, be prepared to go overboard, and be trained on how to handle themselves - on both sides of the rail. This course will teach you how to dramatically improve these odds. If you or a crew member end up in the water and the vessel loses sight of you, there is a four in ten chance you will never be seen again, alive or dead. Drawing on lessons learned from a lifetime in search and rescue and mishap investigation, maritime safety expert Mario Vittone will teach two very different approaches to a man overboard event, crew and vessel preparation, and how to survive if you find yourself in the water.

For over 25 years, Dr. Soltero has been a leader in the design, implementation, and distribution of hardware and software solutions to optimize the performance of digital communication systems on vessels - hardware and software that provide weather, accelerated web browsing, Voice-Over-IP and more. Steve Gershman – Cold Water Awareness & Survival Techniques

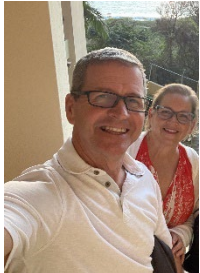


Steve developed this presentation as a result of three professional experienced watermen losing their lives in Southern Maryland in 2021 – all within one month of each other. He will present the causes leading up to those events. The cumulative errors made will be explained in detail, so you can be made aware of the actions precipitating these events and allowing those so inclined to take precautionary actions. Additionally, a video addressing the effects of cold water immersion, should a boater fall overboard and the immediate impact to survivability, will be explained. Afterwards, a tabled display of safety and survivability equipment will be briefed, followed by a question and answer period. Steve's career spanned 33 years in the Federal Government culminating in a senior position in the Dept. of Defense, Office of the Inspector General. Steve was a 10.5 year member of the USCG Auxiliary and is an active volunteer with MD Natural Resources Police, Anne Arundel Police Community Affairs Council and conferred as Member at Large in 2023.

Scott will cover things that he has found on surveys that you wouldn't believe unless you saw it, top contributors to lower values, and the top 10 things to do to keep your boat at its best.
